JV-12-16 – Robert Lane – Jefferson River – This application has been declared a project. An on-site inspection has been completed. This application received the Board's final decision.

JV-13-16 – Devlyn Warren – Lump Gulch Creek – This application has been declared a project. An on-site inspection has been waived. This application was changed to an emergency application as the materials near the stream are covered with soot and ash and need to be removed before the rain season hits. This application has received the Board's final decision.

JV-15-16 – Betty Novich - South Boulder River – This application has been declared a project. An on-site inspection has been completed. This application has been changed to an emergency application as the debris in the river is causing flooding issues with several neighbors. This application received the Board's final decision.

JV-16-16 – Todd Gilstrap – South Boulder River – This application has been declared a project. An on-site inspection has been completed. This application received the Board's final decision.

Kris informed the Board that 120 kids attended the event that day. There were twelve stations that the kids traveled through and even though it was a rainy, cold day and everyone had to be in the barn, the teachers said that the event was run well.
