

**RESOLUTION 5-2012  
CALLING FOR AN ELECTION TO REQUEST A MILL LEVY LIMITATION OF 25  
MILLS FOR THE RUBY VALLEY HOSPITAL**

WHEREAS, the Ruby Valley Hospital District has requested to have a permanent levy of twenty-five (25) mills placed on the May 8, 2012, School Election Ballot in accord with 15-10-425 MCA, and

WHEREAS, in 2008 the mill levy for the Ruby Valley Hospital District was reduced from thirty (30) mills to twenty-five (25) mills, and

WHEREAS, having operated on twenty-five (25) mills for the past four (4) years, the Hospital Board of Trustees feels a permanent levy of twenty-five (25) mills will be adequate for successful operation of the hospital.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that there shall be placed on said May 2012 School Election Ballot the question in the following form:

Shall the Trustees of the Ruby Valley Hospital District be authorized to impose a permanent levy of twenty-five (25) mills each year to raise approximately \$240,000 per year for the continued successful operation of the Ruby Valley Hospital? Such levy shall be in addition to the statutory levy of three (3) mills. If this levy passed, property taxes for a home valued at \$100,000 would be approximately \$36.83 per year and property taxes for a home valued at \$200,000 would be approximately \$73.66 per year.

- FOR a permanent mill levy of twenty-five (25) mills to raise approximately \$240,000 per year for the continued successful operation of the Ruby Valley Hospital.
- AGAINST a permanent mill levy of twenty-five (25) mills to raise approximately \$240,000 per year for the continued successful operation of the Ruby Valley Hospital.
