

**RESOLUTION 28-2011  
A RESOLUTION DECLARING AN EMERGENCY  
IN MADISON COUNTY**

WHEREAS, on August 28, 2011, at approximately 1300 hrs, a fire located up North Meadow Creek was called in to the Madison County dispatch office. The fire started as a brush fire but it was immediately apparent that the fire would travel into forested land and overwhelm the county's resources to fight this fire.

WHEREAS, the County has committed all available resources, taken all possible action to combat and alleviate the situation and local resources are not adequate to cope with the situation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOULVED by the County Commissioners that an emergency is hereby declared pursuant to Section 10-3-402, MCA, and all provisions of the County Emergency Operations Plan are in effect.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that copies of this resolution be filed with the County Clerk and Recorder, County Assessor and the Montana Disaster and Emergency Services Division in Helena.
