

RESOLUTION 35-2009

A RESOLUTION TO ESTABLISH A "GRAVEL PIT REVIEW FEE" TO BE COLLECTED BY THE MADISON COUNTY WEED BOARD FOR APPLICATIONS SUBMITTED TO MINE GRAVEL WITHIN THE COUNTY

WHEREAS, the Madison County Weed Board has recommended that a fee be assessed for the review that the County Weed Department performs in regard to applications submitted to commercially mine gravel within the county, in compliance with the Department of Environmental Quality guidelines; and

WHEREAS, these reviews consist of inspecting the property to be mined and working with the submitting agency to develop a noxious weed management plan, as appropriate; and

WHEREAS, fees will be based on "Madison County Subdivision Review Fee Schedule effective April 2, 2009," of "Madison County Subdivision Regulations" item 8, setting a \$75.00 fee plus mileage at state rate per mile for "Noxious Weed Management Plan", with all collected fees becoming part of the Weed Board budget; and

WHEREAS, based on the recommendation of the Madison County Weed Board, the Board of County Commissioners deems it necessary and appropriate to assess a "gravel pit review fee" in the amount of \$75.00 plus mileage at state rate per mile, on applications submitted to mine gravel within the county.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Board of County Commissioners of Madison County hereby establishes a "gravel pit review fee" in the amount of \$75.00 per gravel pit, plus mileage at state rate per mile, to be collected by the Madison County Weed Board, on applications submitted to mine gravel within the county.
