

ORDINANCE NO. 1-2000

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 3-88

WHEREAS Ordinance 3-88 provides that the maximum speed limit shall be 35 mph upon all Madison County Roads except those excepted therein in paragraphs 1. a., b., and c., and

WHEREAS the speed limit on those roads at the time Ordinance 3-88 was adopted was 55 mph, and the current Madison County Board of County Commissioners (Board) believes that the intent of the Board at the time Ordinance 3-88 was adopted was to retain the speed limit at 55 mph on said excepted roads, and

WHEREAS, the Board believes that 55 mph is a safe, reasonable and proper speed limit on said roads, (County Road Number 359 excepted)

NOW THEREFORE, Ordinance 3-88 is amended to set the speed limit at 55 mph on the following roads:

- a. County Road number 283 joining Harrison and Pony from its junction with U.S. 287 near Harrison to its junction with an unpaved County Road on the lower, easterly edge of Pony, Montana.
- b. The Alder-Centennial County Road number 357 from the upper end of its paved portion in the vicinity of the Ruby Reservoir to the four corner intersection immediately south of Alder, Montana.
