

Do you know you can borrow eLibrary Books & Digital Audiobooks for FREE?



Here's how:



1. Go to mymontanalibrary.org
2. Click on "MontanaLibrary2Go"
3. Browse Montana Library's large collection of eBooks & Digital Audiobooks!
4. Click on the book you want to borrow
5. If the title is available, a "BORROW" button will appear for you to click on.

If it is not available, a "PLACE A HOLD" button will appear.

6. When you click "BORROW", you will be asked to enter your library card number.

If you do not know your number, please call us at 406-843-5346.

7. Once you have signed in, you can either read the title in your browser, or you can download the Kindle version or the EPUB version (for Nooks).
8. To "PLACE A HOLD", you will be asked to enter your email address. When the title becomes available, you will receive an email and you will have 3 days to download the title.
9. Titles can be checked out for either 7 or 14 days. Once the time limit is up, the eBook will "self-destruct" & return itself.

The first time you download an eBook or Audiobook, you may need to download the Overdrive software to your computer. If that is the case, the website will alert you and walk you through the process.
