

FLOOD PLAIN APPEAL APPLICATION – Madison County, Montana

An appeal is a formal review of the Flood Plain Administrator's order, decision to grant, condition or deny a floodplain permit or interpretation of the Regulated Flood Hazard Area boundary. An appeal may be submitted by a landowner or party affected by the order, the permit applicant, or any other party aggrieved by the issuance of a permit. Appeals must be received within 30 days of the date of the decision or order of the Floodplain Administrator. A decision on an appeal of a permit cannot grant or issue a variance.
