Approval of Minutes

Safety Coordinator Report (January February)

Did MSHA refresher for all the road shop guys. DLI inspection at MVM, Harrison Road and Road 3. 1 serious violation at Manor electrical breaker was removed and no cover put on it, had a couple come-a -longs without safety hooks on them at Harrison and a guard on the drill press and one on a hand grinder missing at Road 3. All violations taken care of and paperwork submitted to DLI. Attended new hire orientation, and safety meetings at TRMCC. Distributed ice melt shaker bottles. Hosted a couple of CPR classes, Road 3, Solid waste. Waterline break in courthouse.

COVID-19 Update - Public Health

Madison County currently has 4 active cases taking our overall total to 2,395. We currently do not have any active hospitalizations. No additional fatality's still holding at a total of 23. Public health emergency will be pulled down second week in May. Both county nursing homes are in outbreak status. Tobacco Prevention Specialist been very active, 3 Staff taking CPR certification class, Narcan training ongoing, and 2 staff going to car seat training. Bike rodeo upcoming in May. All staff up to speed on CPR and ICS training. Board of health meeting March 21 at 5:30.

Nursing Homes Update

Madison Valley Manor – Trent Zimmerman reported they are still in outbreak status, mitigated DLI deficiency and paperwork done. Roof replacement in the works. Trent going to a class in emergency preparedness. Keeping up with snow and ice removal and pre-treating sidewalks prior to storm is helping keep tripping hazards to a minimum. Volt Electric performed a complete repair on the light.

Tobacco Root Mountain Care Center – Dave Reintsma reported they have state survey people here today. Health is there now and Fire Life Safety is coming soon. Snow removal has been a real issue and County came down to spread sand in parking lot, thank you for doing that. Roof is still an issue working on that. No

incidents from snow. Air scrubber on roof still work in process. Did a missing resident training, that went well. Fire drill trainings done.
