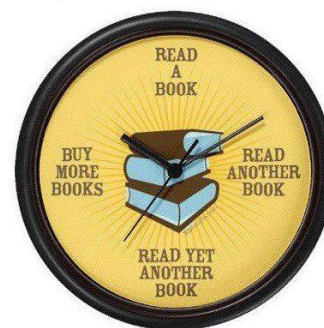

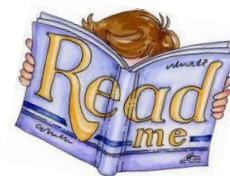
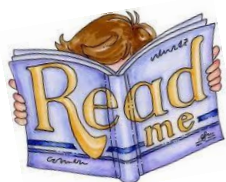

“Thousand Pieces of Gold” by Ruthanne Lum McCunn

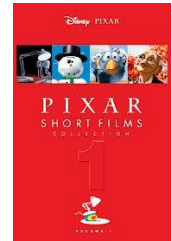
“Recently the library got a reserve request for one of our books, “Thousand Pieces of Gold,” by Ruthanne Lum McCunn. Before I sent the book off to the requesting library, I did a quick perusal of the synopsis on the back of the book. It’s an historical fiction about a Chinese girl, Lalu Nathoy. Through various life events, catastrophes, and misadventures, winds up being shipped to America as a slave to work in a gold mining town in Idaho.



In Idaho she begins a new life as “Polly Bemis.” This book traces her life from impoverished, rural China, to her life in modern Idaho in the Twenties and Thirties. It’s a fascinating, touching read, especially considering Virginia City’s own history and the Asian folks who lived and worked here.
