

RESOLUTION 5-2010

**CALLING FOR AN ELECTION TO RAISE THE MILL LEVY LIMITATION
FOR THE MADISON VALLEY HOSPITAL DISTRICT**

WHEREAS, the Madison Valley Hospital District Governing Board voted unanimously at the December 17, 2009 Board meeting to seek an increase in the Mill Levy by putting it to a vote.

IT IS HEREBY NOTED that of the currently approved 8 mills, 5 mills were approved in June of 2008 and expire in June of 2010, and 3 mills are statutorily authorized and remain in place.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that there shall be placed to a vote on the May 4, 2010, School and Hospital Election ballot the question in the following form:

Shall the Trustees of the Madison Valley Hospital District be authorized to impose an additional levy of 9 mills each year for a period of four (4) years to raise approximately \$690,984 per year for the purpose of supporting the Madison Valley Hospital operations and maintenance? Such levy shall be in addition to the statutorily authorized levy of three (3) mills for a total of 12 mills. If this levy passes, property taxes for a home valued at \$100,000 would increase by approximately \$15.00 per year and property taxes for a home valued at \$200,000 would increase by approximately \$30.00 per year.

FOR the additional levy of 9 mills to raise approximately \$518,238 per year, for the purpose of supporting the Madison Valley Hospital District for four (4) years.

AGAINST the additional levy of 9 mills to raise approximately \$518,238 per year, for the purpose of supporting the Madison Valley Hospital District for four (4) years.
