

RESOLUTION 9-2008

CALLING FOR AN ELECTION TO REQUEST A MILL LEVY LIMITATION OF 25 MILLS FOR THE RUBY VALLEY HOSPITAL

WHEREAS, the Ruby Valley Hospital District has requested to have an additional levy of twenty-five (25) mills placed on the June 2008 Primary Election Ballot in accord with 15-10-425 MCA, and

WHEREAS, the mill levy supported in 2003, which has expired, was for thirty (30) additional mills, and

WHEREAS, the Hospital Board of Trustees feels a lesser levy of twenty-five (25) mills will be adequate for successful operation of the hospital.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that there shall be placed on said June 2008 Primary Election Ballot the question in the following form:

Shall the Trustees of the Ruby Valley Hospital District be authorized to impose a levy of twenty-five (25) mills each year for a period of four (4) years to raise approximately \$225,000 per year for the continued operation of the Ruby Valley Hospital? Such levy shall be in addition to the statutory levy of three (3) mills, but less than the expired 2003 request of thirty (30) mills. If this levy passed, property taxes for a home valued at \$100,000 would be approximately \$49.68 per year and property taxes for a home valued at \$200,000 would be approximately \$99.36 per year.

FOR a mill levy of twenty-five (25) mills for a period of four (4) years to raise approximately \$225,000 per year for the continued successful operation of the Ruby Valley Hospital.

AGAINST a mill levy of twenty-five (25) mills for a period of four (4) years to raise approximately \$225,000 per year for the continued successful operation of the Ruby Valley Hospital.
